1. Introduction

- 1.1. Thank you for visiting <u>www.mexdigital.com</u>, a website, service and platform that provides various services including to Spot Digital Asset Trading which will enable Crypto and Fiat deposits and withdrawals.
- 1.2. In these website terms and conditions (**Terms**), references to **we**, **us**, **our**, means <u>www.mexdigital.com</u>. References to **you** and **your**, are to users of our website.

2. By Using Our Website, You Accept These Terms
